

**LYON COUNTY FISCAL COURT  
REGULAR MEETING  
JUNE 9, 2016**

The Lyon County Fiscal Court met in regular session on Thursday, June 9, 2016 with the following members present: Judge Wade White, Magistrates Bobby Cummins, Danny Walker and County Attorney Lee Wilson.

The invocation was given by Bob Langhi and the court led the pledge to the flag.

On motion made by Mag. Cummins and seconded by Judge White, the court accepted Bob Langhi's bid of \$100 for both metal garage doors. The vote was unanimous. On motion made by Judge White and seconded by Mag. Walker, the court accepted Bob Langhi's bid of \$100 for all metal left over. The vote was unanimous.

The court is not accepting culvert, stone and fuel bids at this time. This will be addressed at the July 14, 2016 fiscal court meeting.

On motion made by Mag. Cummins and seconded by Mag. Danny Walker, the court approved the minutes from the May 12, 2016 fiscal court regular meeting. The vote was unanimous.

On motion made by Judge White and seconded by Mag. Cummins, the court accepted the KOHS Resolution 2016. The vote was unanimous.

On motion made by Mag. Walker and seconded by Mag. Cummins, the court approved the Treasurer's report. The vote was unanimous.


The claims were reviewed and directed to be paid.
