

**Lyon County Fiscal Court
Regular Meeting
May 11, 2017**

The Lyon County Fiscal Court met in regular session, Thursday, May 11, 2017 with the following members present: Judge Wade White, Magistrates Steve Cruce, Danny Walker, Bobby Cummins and County Attorney Lee Wilson.

Bill Allen, minister of music and children from Kuttawa First Baptist Church, gave the invocation. The Court led the pledge to the flag.

Visitor Comments: Amelia Wilson from Congressman James Comer's office introduced Jackson Wilford as a summer intern for the Congressman.

On motion made by Magistrate Cummins and seconded by Magistrate Walker the court approved the minutes from the regular session meeting held April 13, 2017. The vote was unanimous.

On motion made by Magistrate Cummins and seconded by Judge White the court approved the road department report. The vote was unanimous.

On motion made by Magistrate Cummins but for lack of a second the **second reading and passage of the amended alcohol ordinance failed.**

On motion made by Judge White and seconded by Magistrate Walker the court **appointed Francis Baccus to the Library Board for a four-year term ending 6/6/21.** The vote was unanimous.

On motion made by Judge White and seconded by Magistrate Cummins the court voted to move the next scheduled fiscal court meeting to June 13, 2017 at 1:00 pm. The vote was unanimous.

On motion made by Judge White and seconded by Magistrate Walker the court **appoints Rosalee McQueen-Wright, Jeremy Scott and Melissa Wynn to the Nuisance Ordinance Committee.** The vote was unanimous.

On motion made by Magistrate Cummins and seconded by Magistrate Walker the court approved the Lyon County Sheriff's office and City of Kuttawa agreement for law enforcement services. The vote was unanimous.

On motion made by Magistrate Cummins and seconded by Judge White the court approved the transfers. The vote was unanimous.

The Finance Officers, Treasurer's, Clerk's and Sheriff's reports were presented to the Court.
