LYON FISCAL COURT

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO ELECTIONEERING
AT THE POLLING PLACES ON ELECTION DAY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Fiscal Court of the County of Lyon,
Commonwealth of Kentucky:

WHEREAS, KRS 117.235(3) provides that no person shall do
any electioneering at the polling place on election day unless the
Fiscal Court specifically authorizes same by ordinance on a county-
side basis and establishes the distance from the polling place where
such electioneering may be permitted, and

WHEREAS, by custom, electioneering has always been permitted
in Lyon County at the polling place up to within fifty (50) feet of
the voting machine, and

WHEREAS, the growing number of candidates and people election-
eering on behalf of said candidates has presented a growing inconvenience
to the voters of Lyon County,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Fiscal Court of Lyon
County, Kentucky, that electioneering at the polling place on election
day be permitted up to, but not within, a three hundred (300) foot
distance of the voting machine. For the purpose of this ordinance,
electioneering shall include the displaying of signs, the distribution
of campaign literature, cards, or handbills, the soliciting of signa-
tures on any petition, or the solicitation of votes for or against any
candidate or question on the ballot in any manner.

Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be
fined not more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for each offense.
