

SHELTER REGISTRATION PROGRAM INFORMATION

Lyon County Severe Weather Shelter Registration Program is a free and voluntary program. It will allow owners of a personal severe weather shelter located in Lyon County, Kentucky to register their shelter with the Lyon County Emergency Management Agency. Shelter registration is of our effort to be proactive in response to situations that occur as a result of severe and dangerous weather. This program will provide Emergency Service personnel with valuable, timesaving shelter-location data. This data, confidentially held, is critical should a storm shelter exit be blocked or have structural damage caused by a storm.

Information recorded will include the owner's name and telephone number, specific location of the shelter and a brief description of the shelter. We encourage shelter owners to include an out-of-town accountability contact as part of their personal severe weather plan. This information will be maintained by Lyon County Emergency Management personnel and used only in the event of structural damage from severe weather or other related incidents.

The Shelter Registration Program will provide an additional safeguard against being trapped in a shelter. Please be aware that the Emergency Management personnel will conduct a site visit to complete the registration process.
