

ORDINANCE
LYON FISCAL COURT

AN ORDINANCE Relating to approach tile on county on rights-of-ways.

WHEREAS, the improper and inadequate installation of approach tiles has created problems with proper drainage resulting in damage to county roads and,

WHEREAS, the improper and inadequate installation of approach tiles has created situations eventually dangerous to the public's safety;

Be it ordained by the Fiscal Court of Lyon County, Commonwealth of Kentucky:

Section One. No approach tile shall be installed on the county rights-of-ways without first making application for a permit and obtaining such permit from the Lyon County Judge/Executive.

Section Two. Prior to issuing any permit the Lyon County Judge/Executive shall consult with the appropriate magistrate of the magisterial district in which the applicant resides or in which he desires to install said approach tile. In no event shall a permit be issued for the installation of an approach tile with less than a 15 inch diameter and less than 20 feet in length.

Section Three. The violation of this ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor and upon conviction the violator shall be subject of a fine of not less than fifty (50) dollars and not more than three hundred (300) dollars. In addition the vio-

lator shall be liable to the county for any damage caused by the improper and illegal installation and shall further be liable to the county for the costs of removing same.

Section Four. This ordinance shall take effect after its passage and upon publication according to law.
