AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO AND AMENDING
THE COUNTY SYSTEM OF MAINTAIN ROADS
(SIXTH AMENDMENT)

BE IT ORDAINED by the Fiscal Court of the County
of Lyon, Commonwealth of Kentucky:

WHEREAS, an ordinance passed December 1, 1981
established a county system of maintained roads in Lyon
County, and

WHEREAS, certain public roads were designated in
said ordinance which are to be entitled to public
maintenance, and

WHEREAS, the Lyon Fiscal Court is desirous of
designating certain additional roads which should be
entitled to receive public maintenance,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Fiscal Court
of Lyon County, Kentucky, that the following roads
designated on the attached exhibit consisting of one (1)
page be, and they hereby are, officially adopted into and
designated as a part of the county system of maintained
roads in addition to those designated in the aforementioned
ordinance passed December 1, 1981 and the amendments thereto
dated August 5, 1982; December 15, 1983; September 13, 1984;
December 11, 1986; and November 19, 1987.
