WHEREAS, an ordinance passed December 1, 1981 established a county system of maintained roads in Lyon County, and

WHEREAS, certain public roads were designated in said ordinance which are to be entitled to public maintenance, and

WHEREAS, the Lyon Fiscal Court is desirous of designating roads in Worthington Subdivision, more specifically, Whitley Way, South Worthington Way, Washington Way, North Worthington Way, Waterford Way, Wheaton Way, Westminster Way, Westchester Way, Wentworth Way, Wellsley Way, Wellington Way, Weymouth Way and Wyclipp Way, as same are depicted on a plat of said subdivision of record in Plat Cabinet 1, Slide 154, Plat Cabinet 1, Slide 155, Plat Cabinet 1, Slide 156 and Plat Cabinet 2, Slide 33, as being entitled to receive public maintenance,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Fiscal Court of Lyon County, Kentucky, all roads as aforementioned in Worthington Subdivision and hereby are officially adopted into and designated as a part of the county system of maintained roads. This amendment is in addition to those designated in the aforementioned ordinance passed on December 1, 1981 and any amendments thereto.

WHEREAS, certain public roads were designated in said ordinance which are to be entitled to public maintenance, and


