

ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE
ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL PERMITS
APPLICABLE TO COUNTY ROADWAYS IN
LYON COUNTY, KENTUCKY

WHEREAS, the Lyon Fiscal Court has authority, under KRS 189.212, to regulate the operation of motor vehicles which transport cargo in the usual and ordinary course of business, and

WHEREAS, the Lyon Fiscal Court is of the opinion that certain cargo haulers are causing extraordinary damage to county roadways and at the sole expense of the taxpayers of Lyon County, and

WHEREAS, the Lyon Fiscal Court is desirous of safeguarding the structural integrity of its county roadways, thereby keeping same safe for all traveling motorists and persons residing off said roadways,


NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Fiscal Court of Lyon County, Kentucky, that the Lyon Fiscal Court be, and is hereby authorized:

1. To enforce weight limit restrictions as set forth by the state and local governing bodies;
2. To adopt by executive order the amount, terms and conditions of bond or letter of



credit which may be placed upon the cargo haulers if it is determined by the Fiscal Court that the subject hauler is causing damage to the county roadways.
